Cocktail/Dinner Hour

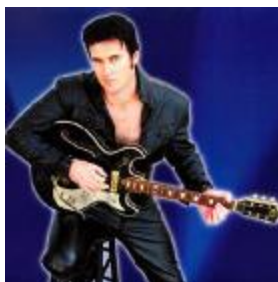
DJ/MC will provide background music as your guests enter the room for their cocktail/dinner hour. The music will be from the 3 musical eras of Las Vegas. During this time, guests will enjoy a slide show playing classic clips from the strip.

Frank Sinatra Era



At the start of the first hour, Frank Sinatra will come on stage and open the show with a classic number chosen by you. After the first number, the casino tables will open for play. Frank will continue to perform throughout the hour. At the halfway point in the hour, Frank will open the stage to any person that would like to do a duet with “Old Blue Eyes.” EC will provide a list of songs for you to choose from. During this time, your guests will enjoy classic “Rat Pack” clips, helping to put you back in the golden years of Veags!

Elvis Era



At the start of the second hour, Elvis will join us on stage and perform his hits. Just like the first hour, Elvis will perform with your guests after the halfway point in the hour. EC will provide a list of songs for you to chose from. During this time, your guests will enjoy classic acts from the 70’s on the big screen.



Modern Day Vegas



To wrap up the last hour, EC will take you to present day Vegas. At the top of the hour, cirque performers will enter the room and perform acts to the audience's delight. You may choose from a list of different entertainers for your hour opener. After the first performance, music from top Vegas shows such as Cirque du Soleil, Blue Man Group, etc. will be playing. The video screen will showcase clips embracing Modern Las Vegas

Show Closer

The last 30 minutes of the night, we will announce the closing of our gaming tables, count up the chips and determine our big winners. We will also have all the entertainers come back out on stage to help with the final raffles and photo opportunities.





CASINO GAMES

Blackjack



Blackjack is amongst the most popular and well recognized of modern Casino games. It is a game between you and the dealer. During a game of Blackjack, cards are dealt from a deck of cards called a shoe. Traditionally a shoe may contain anything from one standard 52-card deck to 6 such decks. Our version of Blackjack is played exclusively with a single 52-card deck, as this offers you the best possible chances of winning.

You will be dealt two cards. The Dealer will be dealt one card. In some Casinos, the Dealer is dealt two cards but only one is turned so that it's value can be revealed. The card that remains face down is called the Hole card.

The object of Blackjack is to obtain a hand with the highest possible value without exceeding 21. All face cards - Kings, Queens and Jacks, have a value of ten and the Aces can have a value of 1 or 11.

If your initial two cards do not total 21 then you may request additional cards, called a Hit. If your hand does not go Bust (exceeds 21) and still does not equal 21 you may continue to request additional cards until your hand goes Bust, reaches 21 or you decide to Stand. If you are dealt a Blackjack (an ace and a card of value ten) then the dealer will automatically lose unless his single card is an Ace or a card of value 10. If you are dealt a Blackjack then he will not be allowed to draw further cards as he already has the best possible hand.

If you go Bust the game is over and the dealer wins. If you reach 21 or choose to Stand the dealer will draw another card. If the dealer's hand is less than 17 in value the dealer must continue to draw cards until his hand's value equals 17 or more. In the event of the dealer not going Bust the value of the dealer and your hands are then compared. If your hand is stronger the Casino will pay you twice the amount originally wagered. If you win on a Blackjack you will be paid out 2.5 times your original bet.



Roulette



Next to Blackjack, Roulette is one of the most popular games played in modern Casinos. It is also amongst one of the oldest Casino games. Roulette is somewhat unique amongst modern table games in that it employs a mechanical device as the key element of the game. This is the large and very distinct Roulette wheel, which is mounted horizontally on one end of the table. The hollow of the wheel has numbered pockets ranging from zero to thirty-six (and a '00' in American Style Roulette).

Wagers in Roulette are placed on an area of the table marked with a pattern of boxes and numbers. This is called the game layout. You may place wagers on any particular number, any 4 adjacent numbers, a column or a 'dozens' bet.

The wheel is used to determine the outcome of a game of Roulette. Once the bets have been placed the wheel is set spinning and a small (usually metal or ivory) ball is spun onto the wheel in the opposite direction to that of the spinning wheel. The ball will rapidly loose speed and eventually stop in one of the pockets. The number of the pocket is the winning number.



Craps



Craps is one of the more exciting and social table games played in casinos today. While the game does look complex and has its own extensive jargon like 'boxcars', 'hard ways' and 'horn bet' it is a relatively simple game to master. Craps is usually played on a large sunken table. On the table's surface is printed a complicated-looking pattern. The game is played with a pair of dice, which are thrown by the 'shooter', a player who is currently holding the dice. Other players may join in and place their own bets.

Playing Craps can be as simple or as complicated as you choose to make it. There are an extensive array of betting options available but you only need to understand a few of them to play the game, have fun and win.

Craps is a game of dice. You are betting on which numbers the next roll of the dice will produce (or won't produce). In its simplest form you (the shooter) will place a bet on the Pass line (or on the Don't Pass Line) and try to roll a seven or an eleven. If you succeed the bet will pay even money and you can make another bet. This first roll is called the 'Come Out' roll.

Should you fail to roll a seven or eleven then a 'point' is established on the number of the value of the dice rolled. Once a point is established your object is to roll the same number again before the next seven is rolled. If a seven is rolled you lose your bet. Once a point has been established you can not remove your bet from the table.
